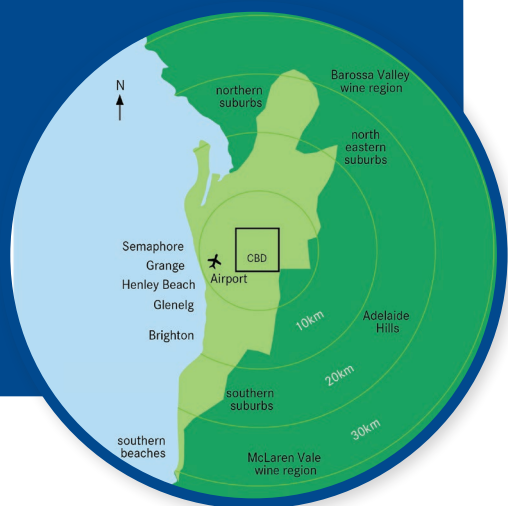

Flexible modes of study and modern facilities

Eynesbury College offers a flexible learning structure and programs are delivered through a variety of modes, not excluding online studies. The campus consists of modern student facilities, equipment and learning resources, including computer rooms, kitchen facilities, a resource centre, dry and wet laboratories, break out areas and accessible student support via our Student and Academic Services Team. The College also has disability access.



Fast-track options, multiple intakes and scholarships

With intakes in February, June and October, students can start their studies when it suits them best. It is possible to complete Foundation Studies or a diploma in as little as 8 months and fast-track into the second year at The University of Adelaide for most programs, subject to program and academic requirements.

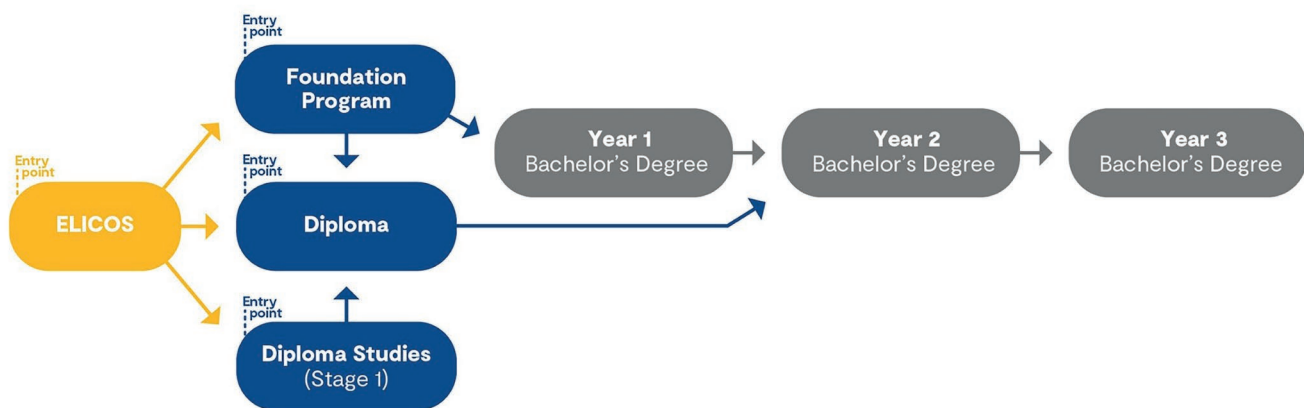

*Entry into The University of Adelaide is based on successful completion of an Eynesbury College diploma or achieving a specified score out of 500 for Foundation Studies Program students. The study plan of each individual student progressing to The University of Adelaide may differ.

Foundation Studies Program

- Foundation Studies Program (FSP) is an 8 or 12 month program, which prepares students for entry into first year of undergraduate study, or an Eynesbury Diploma
- Ability to package with most undergraduate programs at The University of Adelaide
- Eynesbury FSP is recognised by other Australian universities, including the Group of Eight
- A wide range of modules allow you to meet degree pre-requisites
- Students in our FSP consistently achieve excellent results

Diploma Programs

- Eynesbury Diploma programs are specialised into streams of Business, Engineering and Computing & IT
- Eynesbury College offers two different types of Diploma programs: One Year Diploma pathway and Two Stage Diploma pathway
- Multiple intakes allow students to complete the Diploma in as little as 8 months, with direct entry into second year at The University of Adelaide for most programs, subject to meeting program and academic requirements
- Students will study equivalent course content as taught in the first year of the university degree

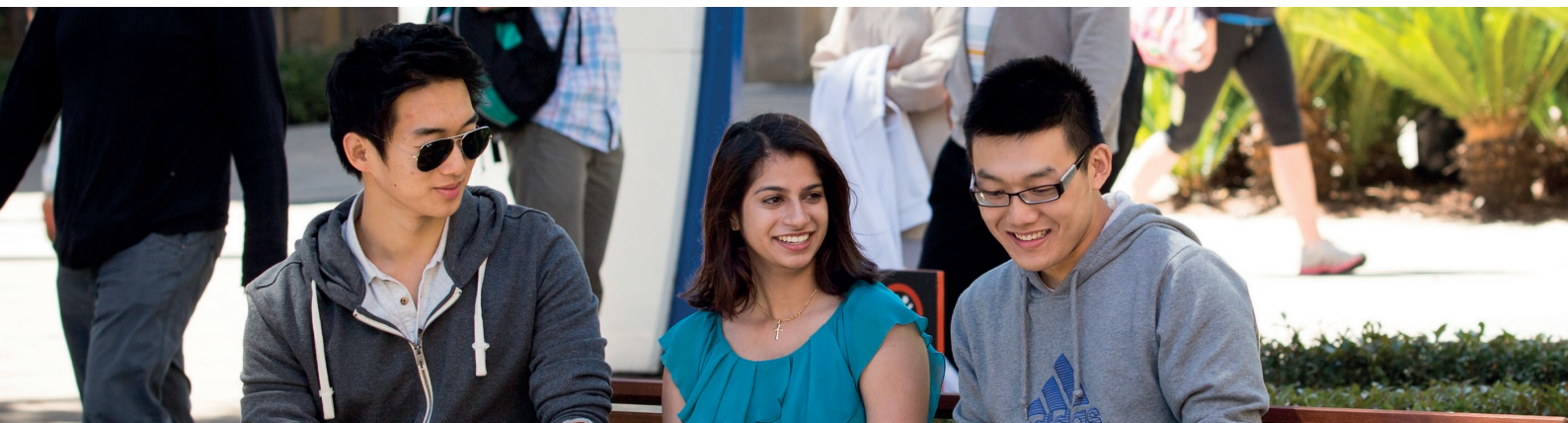
